

ALPINE SCHOOL DISTRICT STEM FORM

(This form must be completed and signed by each person competing at the Alpine School District Fair and attached to the other required Central Utah STEM Fair paperwork)

ATTENTION!!! As of 2015 the state level Central Utah STEM Fair (held at BYU) will NOT allow any items to be displayed with their project boards other than a research journal and an electronic device for displaying pictures or video about the project. However, the Alpine School District level STEM fair will still allow display items as long as the following criteria are met:

Project Display items MUST fit within the following dimensions 30 inches deep, 48 inches wide, and 108 inches tall.

When creating your display board, do NOT include the following:

1. Living organisms, including plant material
2. Taxidermy specimens or parts
3. Preserved animals – includes embryos
4. Food (empty containers may be secured to the display)
5. Human or animal parts or body fluids written permission (must have signatures from others).
6. Soil, sand or waste samples
7. Laboratory/household chemicals – including water surgical techniques, dissection, necropsies, other lab techniques,
8. Poisons, drugs, hazardous substances or devices improper handling methods, improper housing conditions etc.
9. Sharp items – pipettes, syringes, needles (**glass** in any form)
10. Highly flammable display materials (NO matches)
11. Empty tanks that previously contained combustible liquids or gases
12. Batteries with open top cells
13. Photographs of people other than yourself or your family without their consent.
14. Photographs or other visual presentations depicting vertebrate animals in surgical techniques, dissections, necropsies, other lab techniques, improper handling methods, improper housing conditions, etc.

It is recommended that you carefully design and construct your display boards to reflect as well as possible all of the information you want to convey at the state level STEM fair.
