


WHO ARE WE?

Horizon School is a public school in the Alpine School District that serves only students with disabilities. We serve students from preschool through post-high school.

Horizon School contains a transition program for students between the ages of 18-22 called **ATEC-West** (Alpine Transition and Education Center). Students in this program come to learn needed job, community, and life skills .

As a school community we are committed to our district's vision for learning. We believe <u>every</u> student can learn needed knowledge, skills, and dispositions that set them up for successful and meaningful lives.



PLACEMENT AND TOURS

Not just any student with a disability comes to Horizon. Because our setting is considered a more restrictive environment than a special education class in a typical school, the decision to come here is a collaborative process.

Placement for students that come to Horizon School is based on a decision of the IEP team in coordination with our district Special School and Transition Coordinator, Jill Allgaier. Jill also will schedule tours for parents. She can be reached at (801) 610-8202.

SERVICES

Horizon School offers specialized instruction in reading, writing, math, and life skills that addresses needs of individual students in conjunction with their IEPs.

We also work as a team with the following professionals: Vision specialists, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, Nursing, and our School Psychologist.
