We wanted to highlight our school-wide priorities so everyone in our community understands what we are working towards. These priorities will support our efforts to pursue our district's Vision for Learning. We have set priorities in the following 3 areas: School-wide Achievement, Student-Group Achievement, and Student Connection. In coordination with our leadership and collaborative teams we have set the following goals:

<mark>School-Wide Achievement</mark>: Students will make sufficient progress on their IEP goals in academic, functional, or transition areas.

• We focus on progressing with IEP goals because every student in our school has an IEP. We teach specific goals for every student and track data to monitor progress.

<mark>Student Group</mark>: Students with Behavior Intervention Plans will make adequate progress in their behavior and other IEP goals as determined by each IEP team.

• Behavior can be a significant barrier for a student to learn. By focusing on our students who have formal behavioral supports, we seek to improve behavior which in turn will improve learning.

<mark>Student Connection</mark>: Every staff member in Horizon and ATEC West will learn all student names in their respective campuses.

• When someone knows our name, we feel connected to them. It's critical that every student has a team of adults in the building who know who they are and can help them feel seen. There is power in knowing a name and we will learn names schoolwide to facilitate connection and belonging. This is just the first step in striving for deeper student connection.

We have a great team and look forward to deliberately chasing these priorities this year! Thank you for your support as we live our mission, vision, core values and goals and achieve high levels of wellbeing and learning for *every* student.
